■ **What is your cancellation policy?**

Cancellation 60 - 31 days prior – 20% fee applies
Cancellation 30 – 15 days prior – 50% fee applies
Cancellation within 14 days – 100% fee applies

Food & wine

■ Is James Halliday attending?

James Halliday will not be in attendance; however, Halliday Tasting Team member, Dave Brookes, will be there to host a four-course food and wine experience on Saturday night. The evening will focus on locally sourced produce and highly rated Halliday wines.

■ Will the meals cater to any dietary requirements?

Yes, we can cater to dietary requirements. Please make sure you've stated these in the form prior to departure.

■ Are wines included in the price?

A selection of Halliday rates wines will be available as part of the casual dining experience. The Saturday evening masterclass will also have highly rated Halliday wines included as part of the package.

Additional drinks will be available via the Barnbougles Sports Bar throughout the day, at times outside of planned activities, however, these must be purchased.

■ Is there a dress code?

Saturday night's four-course dinner has a smart casual dress code.

Golf

■ Am I able to hire a golf cart?

The Dunes and Lost Farm are walk courses only. We can however offer escorted carts to those with a medical condition that prohibits them from being able to walk the course. An escorted ride means having a caddy who will drive the cart as self-drive is not permitted on our courses.

Costs are \$40 per round for the motorised cart (payable to the pro shop on the day) and a minimum of \$80 to the caddy (paid directly to the caddy at the completion of the round in cash only). An escorted cart can only take the one passenger (with a medical certificate); however, it can take two golf bags.

For those walking, pull buggies are included in the package price.

■ Can I play on the Bougles Run course?

Barnbougles's new 14-hole short course is available to be booked to play on Saturday afternoon, or if you are extending your trip, on another date. The cost is \$80 per person, per round.

■ Can I hire golf clubs?

Yes, we have the following hire clubs available at the Dunes and Lost Farm:

Executive Set \$55.00 includes pull buggy

Standard Set \$35.00 including pull buggy

■ How will the competition be scored?

The competition will be scored using the Stableford scoring system. The Stableford system, rather than counting the total number of strokes taken, involves scoring points based on the number of strokes taken at each hole. The objective in Stableford, therefore, is to have the highest score – unlike traditional scoring methods.

■ How will the teams and playing groups be chosen?

The Halliday Cup will be played in pairs, chosen based on the preferences provided in the additional information form that all participants should have completed.

Each group on the course will be a group of four players. The event is a pairs competition so if three people have booked together – two of them will be a pair (for the event), the other player will be paired up with another single that has booked for the event, but all three (plus the 3rd persons partner) will play in a group.

■ I don't have a handicap; will I be assigned one?

Yes, we will allocate a handicap to those without an official GA Handicap. This will be 18 for men and 24 for women.

■ Do you have a dress code on course?

All golfers are required to wear a collared shirt on course. Golf shoes are preferred however soft soled shoes e.g. sneakers are acceptable.
